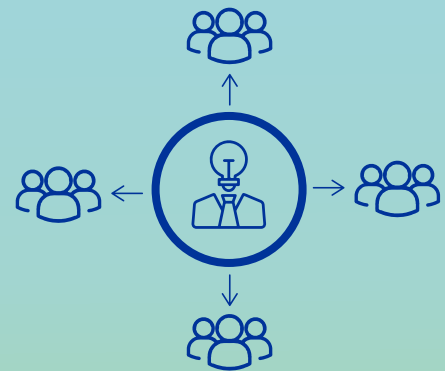

Mentors

What is the role of a mentor?

Mentors serve as seasoned experts in a particular field, offering support to participants facing challenges or seeking guidance on specific ideas. Your primary tasks include providing constructive feedback during sessions and addressing any queries that may arise throughout the various activities.

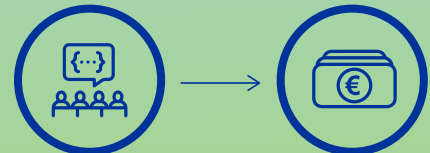
As a mentor, you will be actively involved in the entirety of the hackathon, spanning 16 hours across four sessions: Thursday afternoon, Friday afternoon, Saturday morning, and Saturday afternoon.



What can you expect to receive?

All mentors will undergo comprehensive training and will receive necessary materials and assistance throughout the execution of the hackathon.

For each complete hackathon you engage in, you will receive remuneration amounting to €900.



When is your participation expected?

The hackathons are scheduled to take place during May and June 2024. Mentors can participate in multiple hackathons based on their availability and expertise.
